Kenston's Henry leads area charge at sectional

Kenston's Nicki Henry shot a medalist round of 79 to lead the Bombers to a second-place finish in the Division I sectional golf tournament at Tamer Win Golf Course in Cortland. Henry, a sophomore, double-bogeyed the first two holes and bogeyed No. 3. Over the last 15 holes, Henry shot even par.

"It was exciting, even though I started off a little rough," Henry said. "I played well after that."

Cassie Johnson shot an 87, followed by Eleni Seminario (93), Ali Read (94) and Lauren O'Connor (95).

Kenston totaled 353 points to finish second, four strokes behind tournament champion Canfield (349).

Also qualifying for next week's district at Legends of Massillon were South (357) and Warren Howland (376).

Area individual qualifiers were Mentor's Megan Lundblad and Taylor Wilson.

South was led by Lisa Barber's 80. Other Rebels golfers included Kristen Vidmar (90), Nicole DiMarco (91), Jessica Ryan (96) and Jenna Burkhart (110).

"I told my assistant, if we shoot in the 350s, we'll get out to districts," South coach Ken Kary said. "I thought we had a good chance to win it, but Canfield posted a good score."
