Chagrin Falls' Henry stars in NCJT event at Blackbrook

Nicki Henry of Chagrin Falls had an outstanding round as she won the North Coast Junior Tour event at Blackbrook Country Club in Mentor.

Henry shot 77 to earn victory over Halley Morell of Brecksville by six strokes in the 12-15 age group. Henry's consistent 39-38 bettered Morell's 83, three strokes less than Emily Jereb of Concord. Aly Ales of Solon was sev-

enth as she shot 97 and Kelly Poe of Chagrin Falls was ninth at 99. Beachwood's Lisa Blumenthal was 10th with 105.

• Andrew Domeck of Hunting Valley won again as he shared victory with Ron Ritner III of Willoughby Hills in the age 16-19 group. Both carded 74 to top Justin Behr of Aurora and Zach Fedele of Madison by one stroke.

Domeck had an even 37-37 on the front and back nine, but Ritner III shot 35 on his back to catch Domeck.

Jonathan Riemer of Lyndhurst came in sixth with 76, two strokes off the lead. Riemer continues to lead the 16-19 division in total points with 509.

Paul Mann of Highland Heights was tied in 12th as he carded 79, along with Alex Urbancsik of Mentor.

• Among age 14-15 boys, Christian Wagner of Chagrin Falls tied with Allan Poe of Concord in fifth place at 75, two strokes off the pace set by co-medalists Nick Popely of Painesville and Tyler McHugh of Macedonia.

Chad Nock of Twinsburg shot 77 to tie with Austin McNair of Aurora and Jackson Stroup of Hudson in seventh. Doug Revak and Nick Lattanzi, both of Chagrin

Falls, each shot 79 to tie for 11th.

Other area finishers in the 14-15 group were Adam Rukin of Pepper Pike (tied in 17th at 83), Chad Owen of Russell (tied in 22nd, 86) and Jonathan Fishman of Beachwood (tied in 27th, 88).

• In the boys' youngest 12-13 age group, Jack Mazanec of Solon came in sixth at 88. Will Widman of Chagrin

Falls was 12th with an even 100. Andrew Britton of Waterford, Pa., was medalist with 81.

• The girls' 16-19 grouping was won by Michelle Ford of Ashtabula with an impressive 69, six strokes ahead of Nicole Trivisonno of Wickliffe.

Keely Lavelle of Shaker Heights was tied in fifth with Gina Battistone of Northfield at 81. Robin Mason of Solon was eighth with 121.
