Bruell wins Tour Championship

The North Coast Junior Tour conducted its premier event and **Julian Bruell** of Shaker Heights won the annual Tour Championship, held at Quail Hollow Resort in Painesville.

Bruell held off **William Reitan** of Chagrin Falls by one stroke in the 16-19 age group. Bruell fired a two-day total of 151, scoring with a closing 73. Reitan shot 75 in the second round.

Jonathan Riemer of Lyndhurst tied for third at 153 with

Wesley Domeck of Aurora and **Kevin McDonald** of Erie, Pa.

David Wien of Orange was tied in sixth with **Derek Aicher** of Erie at 154. **Andrew Domeck** of Hunting Valley was in eighth with **Louis Durban** of Cleveland at 159.

• Another area winner was **Nicki Henry** of Chagrin Falls, medalist for girls 12-15. Henry opened with 72 and cruised to victory with a closing 76. Her total of 148 was four shots better than **Danielle Nicholson** of Geneva.

• In girls 16-19 competi-

tion, **Caitlin Kempton** of Shaker Heights nearly made a great comeback as she shot 76 in the second round, a low for the tournament, but fell one shot behind **Katie Kohut** of Twinsburg.

Nikki Sarkisian of Chagrin Falls was ninth at 198.

• Among boys 14-15, **Dylan Zabell** of Moreland Hills came in sixth with 162. **Tyler McHugh** of Macedonia and **Chad Nock** of Twinsburg tied for first at 152.

Christian Wagner and **Doug Revak**, both from Chagrin Falls, totaled 167, good for eighth. **Nick Lattanzi** of Chagrin Falls was three strokes behind at 170, tied with **Matt Ranney** of Mentor.

• **Benjamin Meola** of Painesville won boys 12-13. His 160 was five strokes ahead of the field.
