Nicki Henry has her own sector of the foundation called Birdies for ALS. With every birdie she gets, a donation will be made to Bright Side of the Road. A birdie is one stroke under par, which is usually 3, 4, or 5 strokes depending on the difficulty of the hole. The birdies will only be counted from her tournament schedule. Her goal is to get 50 birdies within the season. She is already at 47.

Nicki will keep raising money during her senior year and hopefully through college. By golfing for ALS, she is hoping to inspire someone else to do the same thing.
