Kenston's Henry is fifth at state

Nicki Henry of Kenston finished in a three-way tie for fifth place at the Division I girls state golf tournament on Friday and Saturday at The Ohio State University Gray Golf Course in Columbus.

Henry shot a 153 for the two rounds, which tied her with **Erin Michel** of Mason and **Stephanie St. Jean** of Findlay.

Henry, a senior, shot a 75 in the first round and a 78 in the second round as she earned first team All-Ohio honors. Last season Henry reached

the state tournament and was second team All-Ohio.

Emily Wright of Mason was the individual state champion as she shot a 142, which is five strokes better than runner up **Jessica Porvasnik** of Medina Highland.

Mason won the team state championship as well with a total of 611. Massillon Jackson was second at 635.
